Restricts the sale of dextromethorphan

Provides with respect to privileges for health care providers

SB 410, Mills

Provides for the transparency of Maximum Allowable Cost Lists for prescription drugs

Provides for a public benefit assessment by the Department of Health and Hospitals

Provides for transfer of the lead agency for the Child Care and Development Fund Block Grant and the transfer of oversight and administration of licensing and regulation of early learning centers from the Department of Children and Family Services to the Department of Education
