**Subject: Hurricane Preparedness 2016**

This memo is to remind you to review your vaccine emergency storage plan for all vaccines in your inventory. In accordance with the Vaccines for Children (VFC) Provider Agreement Emergency Vaccine Management Plan, an emergency vaccine storage plan is required of all VFC providers. This pre-planning is necessary to ensure proper vaccine storage in the event of a power failure.

Your close attention to this request helps us save millions of dollars in vaccines currently held in statewide provider inventories, in the event of a hurricane-related emergency. Please help us prevent needless and unsustainable loss of vaccine by detailing a plan for vaccine in your office in the event of a power failure.
