HB 63, Leger

Revises terminology referring to persons with disabilities and other persons with exceptionalities

HB 305, Hoffmann

Prohibits providers of elective abortions and their affiliates from delivering any instruction or materials in schools

HB 330, Lopinto

Authorizes the use of electronic means for the delivery of an order for protective custody and transportation to the sheriff

HB 348, Badon

Prohibits termination of life-sustaining procedures for pregnant women

HB 406, Burns

Requires the consideration of certain provider impact issues and issuance of a provider impact statement prior to the adoption, amendment, or repeal of rules by a state agency

HB 464, Broadwater

Establishes a pilot initiative for training and education to serve certain recipients of Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits

Provides with respect to notice requirements for qualified health plan issuers on the health insurance exchange

Provides for information included in the executive budget and the General Appropriation Bill

HB 1215, Johnson

Provides relative to collaborative practice agreements between advanced practice registered nurses and physicians

HB 1264, Hoffmann

Prohibits the sale of electronic cigarettes and vapor products to persons under the age of eighteen

HCR 43, Carmody

Requests the State Board of Medical Examiners to study and make recommendations concerning authorization to perform certain surgical procedures

April 21, 2014 House Engrossed, passed to 3rd reading

SB 165, Murray

Provides relative to prescription drug specialty tiers

April 24, 2014 Senate Engrossed, passed to 3rd reading

SB 403, Mills

Provides relative to third party payments of health insurance premiums of individuals with HIV/AIDS

SCR 62, Mills

Requests the Department of Health and Hospitals to seek a Medicaid state plan amendment from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to include as a Medicaid service the Tdap vaccine to pregnant women and to provide a cost analysis to the legislature for providing this Medicaid service.
